Getting Started

- Go to the University's homepage (<u>http://www.wlv.ac.uk</u>)
- Click on Current Students, then Learning Centres.
- Select Electronic Resources, then Athens information and follow the instructions for logging on using a University or Non-University PC. If you are using a PC outside the University you may be asked to enter your university PC login ID and password.
- At the Electronic Resources page, select Databases A-Z
- Click on M and choose Maternity and Infant Care from the list

Searching

The screen below will be displayed. You can use the default **Basic Search** or you can use the **Advanced Ovid Search** which enables you to search for specific keywords, authors, titles, or journals.

Enter your **search term(s)** into the search box.

At this point you can also **limit** your results. There are a number of different limiter options to help you narrow down your search to retrieve relevant results.

You may wish to limit to **full text** articles only (although bear in mind that some articles may be available on other databases) or limit to articles within a particular **publication year** range (e.g. if you are interested in articles published between 2005 and 2009 for recent articles).

You can also limit your search to a certain **subject area** (hold down the control button on your keyboard whilst clicking to select more than one subject) or **country**.

Once you have chosen any limiters click on Search >>.

The links on the right of the screen provide you with more detailed information about each result:

- Click Abstract or View Abstract to obtain a brief summary of the research
- Click Complete Reference to view further information including index terms
- Click **Full Text** to view the article in full (once you have opened the full text in the database there is sometimes the option to open as a pdf which you can then easily save/print)
- Click Library Holdings to check the OPAC to see if we have any print copies of the journal
- Click Internet Resources to see if there any associated links via the internet
- Click the **Search for Article** button to see if we have the article on another of our electronic databases
- Click **Find Citing Articles** to find other articles that have referenced that article (you may find that these are also relevant to your research)
